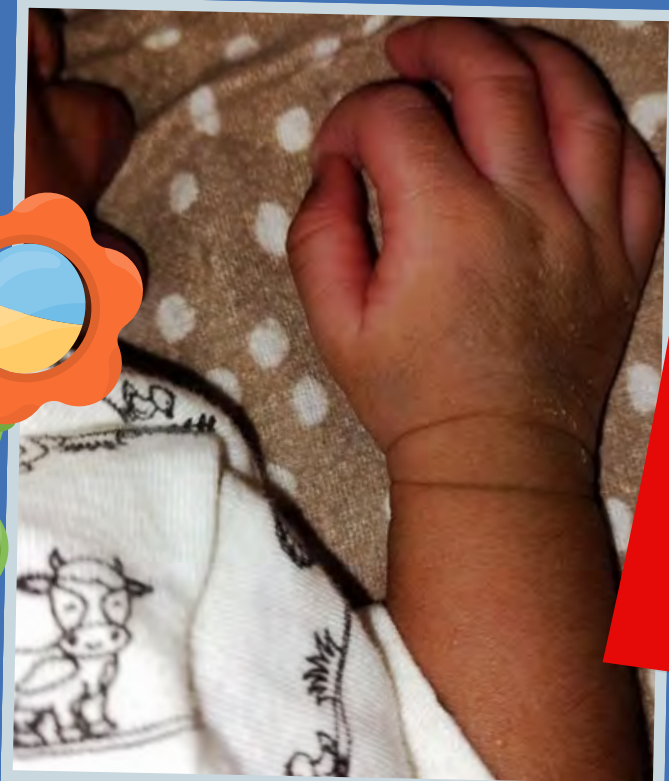


OUR MONTHLY RECAP
