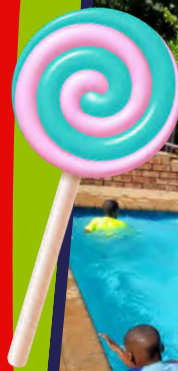
Beach Clean-Up
